3. Participants will be asked to brainstorm ideas and will have input as to preferred choices.

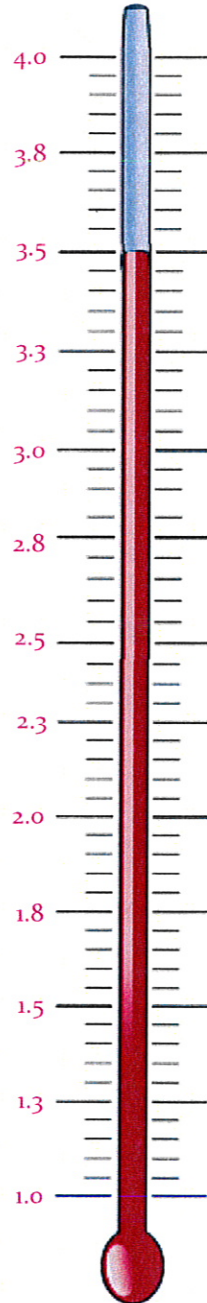
