

VILLAGE OF LIONS BAY

BY-LAW NO. 140, 1985.

A By-law to prohibit the keeping of animals.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act provides that Council may by By-law prohibit the keeping of animals;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Lions Bay in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. No person shall cause or permit to be kept on a parcel in the Village:
 - (a) poultry or swine; or
 - (b) a horse, mule, sheep, goat, cow or other animal of the bovine species;
2. Not more than four (4) household pets, namely cats, dogs, caged birds, rabbits, or rodents, are permitted on a parcel in the Village, provided that no public nuisance is created.
3. Every person who violates a provision of this By-law or who allows, causes, or permits an infraction of this By-law shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable upon conviction for a maximum fine of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) and the cost of prosecution.
4. An infraction of this By-law which continues for a period in excess of one (1) calendar day shall be deemed to be and is punishable as a separate infraction for each and every subsequent day until such infraction ceases.
5. This By-law may be cited as "The Prohibition of Livestock By-law No. 140, 1985".






