BY-LAW NO. 220

ELECTIONS REGULATIONS 1993

A by-law to provide for the determination of various procedures for the conduct of local government elections and other voting

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act*, provides opportunities for the Council to, by by-law, determine various procedures and requirements to be applied in the conduct of local government elections and other voting,

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it appropriate to establish various procedures and requirements under that authority,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Lions Bay in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS:

1. In this by-law:

ELECTION means an election for the number of persons required to fill a local government office;

GENERAL LOCAL ELECTION means the elections held for the mayor and all councillors of the municipality which must be held in the year 1993 and in every 3rd year after that;

GENERAL VOTING DAY means:

- (a) for a general local election, the 3rd Saturday of November in the year of the election;
- (b) for other elections, the date set under Sections 38 (5), 39 (1) or (3) or 142 (5) of the *Municipal Act* ; and
- (c) for other voting, the date set under Section 162 of the *Municipal Act* ;

LOCAL GOVERNMENT means the Council of the Village of Lions Bay;

OTHER VOTING means voting on a matter referred to in Section 158 of the *Municipal Act* and includes voting on a referendum under Section 283 of that *Act*.

ADVANCE VOTING OPPORTUNITIES:

2. Pursuant to Sections 97 and 98 of the *Municipal Act*, the following advance voting opportunities are established for each election, to be held in advance of general voting day for each election as follows:

- (a) the required advance voting opportunity will be held on the tenth day before general voting day from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. for each election;
- (b) the advance voting opportunity referred to in Section 97 (2) (b) of the *Municipal Act* will not be held for the general local election;
- (c) an additional advance voting opportunity will be held on the fourth day before general voting day;
- (d) all advance voting opportunities will be held at the Municipal Hall;
- (e) the voting hours at the additional advance voting opportunity will be from 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon;

RESOLUTION OF TIE VOTES AFTER JUDICIAL RECOUNT:

- 3. In the event of a tie vote after a judicial recount, the tie vote will be resolved by conducting a lot in accordance with Section 141 of the *Municipal Act*.

TITLE:

- 4. This by-law shall be cited for all purposes as "Elections Regulations By-law No. 220,1993".
