Amending Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw

The Council of the Village of Lions Bay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Citation

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “Bylaw Number 415, Amending Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw, No. 385, 2006”
2. If a portion of this bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this Bylaw is deemed to have been adopted without the severed section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or phrase.

Amendments

1. In Section 9.2 of Bylaw Number 385, 2006, sections 9.2.1, 9.2.2, 9.2.3 and 9.2.4 are deleted and replaced with the following new sections regarding the designated classes of persons that may be appointed as screening officers:

Section 9.2.1	Village Manager
Section 9.2.2	Corporate Secretary
Section 9.2.3	Treasurer
Section 9.2.4	Bylaw Enforcement Officer
2. In Section 11.1.1.(b) of Bylaw Number 385, 2006, the wording “A municipal police force” is deleted and replaced with the wording “The Royal Canadian Mounted Police.”
3. Schedule A to Bylaw No. 385 is deleted and replaced with the new Schedule A which is attached.
