GETTING STARTED WITH WASTE CONTROL SERVICES (WCS)



WCS is preparing to start servicing Lions Bay. Please see below for information to help with the transition.

With your utility bill you should have received a Lions Bay Brochure. It has the collection calendar and a guide on the acceptable items for recycling, organics and garbage. Refresh your memory on what can go in your recycling and organics. If you have misplaced your brochure you can find it online on

the Village of Lions Bay [website](#).

One change that residents can look forward to is segregating glass from your blue bin. Your glass bin doesn't have to go out every week, so put it out when it is full next to your blue bin. On April 7th WCS will be dropping off at each single family home a grey bin for your glass and a new yellow bag for recycling your paper. Please continue to use the blue bins you currently have for your recyclable containers.

Please have all your **bins out by 7:30am** on the day of service as we will start collecting at this time and don't want to miss picking up your bins.

We have received inquiries about recycling plastic bags and we would like to clarify that these **cannot go into your blue bin**. The processing facility that sorts the recyclables from Lions Bay faces disruptions and damage to equipment when plastic bags are mixed with containers. We ask residents to bring their plastic bags to a recycling depot (same depot that redeems deposit containers). The option for residents is WCS's Beyond the Blue Box Community Depot in North Vancouver. Check out our [webpage](#) dedicated to the depot to learn what residents can bring at no cost

with proof of residency. Do note we are not a transfer station for waste. We do however have very knowledgeable staff who are more than happy to direct you somewhere to take items we might not be able to accept.

We look forward to being in your community and stay tuned over the next few weeks for resident education seminars where WCS staff dedicated to recycling will be available to answer questions and help educate on recycling and sustainable practices.

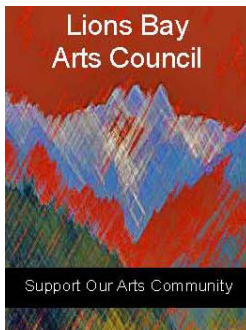
BC TRANSIT SURVEY

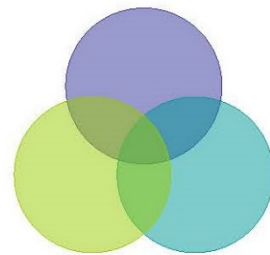
LIONS BAY ARTS COUNCIL - 2017 ARTS AND GARDEN FESTIVAL
